Judge/Executive Kay opened the public hearing for the purpose of discussing the proposed tax rate for Woodford County for tax year 2021. This hearing was advertised properly on the Woodford County, Kentucky Facebook page as well as the Woodford County, Kentucky website and was sent to the *Woodford Sun*, which gave notice for any citizen to submit comments, questions, concerns and/or opinions to the court via phone call or in writing before this date as well as live comments via the live stream during the public hearing. There were no citizen questions submitted.

Judge/Executive Kay opened the public hearing with remarks that reminded citizens this public hearing was to allow the community to be heard on the very important issue of the proposed tax rate for Woodford County for the year 2021, of which is proposed to remain at 7 cents per 100, which is to keep the tax rate the same as previous years.
