Hello.

We are grateful to have such a committed food service staff to provide meals for the children of Woodford County during this unprecedented time. As you know, the health and safety of our students, staff, and community are top priorities for Woodford County Public Schools. We are committed to following the recommendations of our local health department as well as state health officials. As such, it has become necessary to make changes to our current meal service program during school closure.

All school sites will remain open for free meals Monday - Friday from 11:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. through the end of this week (March 23rd - 27th). However, food service workers are no longer able to hand your child(ren)'s meal(s) to you in a drive-through manner. Instead, meals will be on a table. You must exit your car and pick up your meal(s) from the table. A food service worker will be on-site to help but will be practicing social distancing by standing at least six feet away from the table.

For additional access to meals, we will be sending two buses into the community. Buses will be at the following locations during the designated times for meal service:

Similar to the schools, bus drivers and food service workers are not able to hand out meals directly. There will be a table with meals on it, you must come to the table and pick up your child(ren)'s meal(s).

Whether you come to a school for a meal or visit one of the bus locations, please maintain six feet of separation from all other people.

Lastly, to prevent the spread of COVID-19, we are no longer able to make home deliveries. If you have been relying on home delivery, please ask a family member or neighbor to help you with transportation during this time. We apologize for this change but must act in accordance with the health and safety recommendations. Information regarding meal service for spring break and beyond will be provided on Friday.
